## Tucker's Point Hotel & Spa Promises A Summer Filled with “Fabulous Family Fun”

*Special Package, Children's Camp and Kid-Friendly Features  
Add a Family Spin to Bermuda's Newest Luxury Resort*

BERMUDA – June 30, 2010 – [Tucker's Point Hotel & Spa](#), which welcomed its first discerning guests last April, is now rolling out the red carpet for the junior jet set, just in time for summer. With camps catering to young golfers and tennis aces, scuba divers and sailors, Bermuda's first new luxury resort in nearly 40 years has created a summer program brimming with family appeal, complete with a **Fabulous Family Fun** package to help parents pull together a vacation all ages will treasure.

The **Fabulous Family Fun** package includes a well-deserved 50-minute spa treatment just for mom, up to four passes to Bermuda's famous Crystal Caves, a one-hour Junior Golf Clinic for the family's future PGA pro, a complimentary dining menu for children under 12, and a 50 percent discount on a second room for children under 18. Available June 1 through August 31, 2010, the package is \$675 per night.

**Camp Seahorse**, which will be expanded beyond Summer 2010 to all major holidays as well, promises endless fun for youngsters ages five to 12. Kids will fill their days with arts and crafts, water sports, expeditions, scavenger hunts, golf, tennis, swimming, talent shows and more, all under the supervision of the resort's experienced camp staff. Camp rates range from \$75 for a half day (9 a.m. to noon) and \$150 for a full day (9 a.m. to 3 p.m.). Weekly rates are also available at \$230 half day/\$440 full day; upon arrival please inquire about special discounts available for hotel guests. All campers receive a special camp T-shirt, and full-day campers are provided with lunch. Camp Seahorse's summer season runs from July 5 through August 27, 2010.

It is said that a “must do” while vacationing at Tucker's Point is to see the hotel from the water, and the **Dive & Watersports Centre** offers just that with guided, experiential cruises to nearby caves, 300 shipwrecks, 200 square miles of untouched coral reef and dive sites, all aboard The Tidal Pull, a 31 foot dive boat helmed by a knowledgeable captain. Windsurfing, deep sea fishing, a fleet of Kruger and Laser boats for sailing, dive equipment and other various water sport activities are all available to resort guests. Two hour beginner sailing lessons are also offered for \$125 per person, and include pointers such as how to rig a boat, identifying the stern and bow as well as other basic parts of the boat, adjusting the sails in accordance to the wind, how to right a capsized boat and how to properly de-rig a boat. The

Dive & Watersports Centre also entices young guests with its 25-foot water trampoline, jumps and slides for hours of fun in the sun.

For guests ten years and older who want to see what lies beneath the turquoise waters, scuba diving classes provide an up-close look at Bermuda's beautiful coral reefs, wide variety of fish, and shipwrecks. Tucker's Point offers a PADI sanctioned resort course, "**Discover SCUBA**," where instructors first provide an introductory lesson in the pool, then board the 31-foot Tidal Pull for the dive. Classes are offered daily at 10:45 a.m. and cost \$75 for the pool experience and \$150 for both the pool and dive. The Tidal Pull is stocked with water, towels, tea, coffee and snacks.

Guests can also enjoy a **Snorkel Safari to a Nature Reserve** for a three-hour excursion to Tom Moore's Jungle, which includes a one-mile, guided snorkel along a pristine section of Castle Harbour shoreline, with the guidance of a hand-held, James Bond-style propulsion motor to pull the swimmers along. Once at the nature reserve, a "jungle hike" to pristine caves is offered, and participants can swim amongst stalactites and stalagmites. The final stop will be to Tom Moore's Tavern before heading back to Tucker's Point Hotel & Spa. The Deluxe Tour is \$175 per person and includes a stop to relax on the patio at Tom Moore's Tavern for lunch. The Regular Tour is \$110 per person and includes snacks and beverages on the patio. Both tours, custom-made for larger families and groups, have a six-person minimum and include guide, towels and equipment. Seasonal whale watching cruises can also be arranged by the Watersports team.

Those more comfortable on land can hit the links with Tucker's Point's **Junior Golf Camp** where children will be taught everything from golf course etiquette to essential skills in four-hour daily clinics, which are offered on a weekly basis and are designed for youngsters ages five - 12. A ratio of six golfers per instructor ensures ample individual attention from the club's team of pros. Instruction includes golf swing, bunker play, chipping, pitching, putting, rules, and plenty of on-course play. Contests and prizes keep motivation high. Scheduled Monday through Friday during the months of July and August from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m., the week long junior camp is \$325 for members and \$400 for guests per week, and includes lunch and the use of clubs.

**Junior Tennis** provides lessons for toddlers to teens at every skill level: **First Swings** (Saturdays from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m.) is an entry level class for children ages five to seven, focusing on the basic strokes, forehand and backhand swings, and hand-eye coordination. **Little Tennis** (Thursdays from 4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.), is for tots that have played the game before or have already completed the Tucker's Point First Swings program. This level reinforces the basics and helps children understand the fundamentals of the game. **Rally Ball** (Saturdays from 4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.), for kids ages eight to 16, introduces friendly competition. **Junior Aces** (Wednesdays from 5:00 p.m. – 6:00 p.m.) is an advanced beginner program for children ages eight to 16; while **Advanced Junior Training** (Tuesdays from 4:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.) is the advanced program, which works on tactics and winning strategies for playing both singles and doubles.

In addition to the new programming, guests of Tucker's Point Hotel & Spa can avail themselves to a wide array of accommodations. From Manor House hotel rooms furnished

with double queen beds, to sprawling one bedroom suites including a choice of villa residences ideal for fitting everyone from grandparents to nannies under one sprawling roof. Families of all sizes will find their lodging of choice at Tucker's Point.
