

Rosewood & Heather Nova Raise \$4,000 For Charity



Rosewood Bermuda partnered with Bermudian singer-songwriter Heather Nova to raise more than \$4,000 for the Family Centre charity.

A spokesperson said, "The resort collaborated with Heather, whose tour in Europe was canceled due to the pandemic, to host an intimate dinner series at the Beach Club exclusive for members of Tucker's Point, which kicked off on July 5 and followed all health and safety regulations.

"Collectively, the property raised more than \$4,000 USD for Family Centre.
